

Travels in American Jewish History

Important Information

Tour Pricing:

\$885.00 (per person) which includes a \$185 non-refundable registration fee. Registration includes all tours and 11 meals (all meals except one free night out). The fee does **NOT INCLUDE** travel to and from San Francisco or the price of your stay in the hotel. In order to save a spot, you may pay the registration fee and then pay the balance by April 1, 2017, or you may pay the entire fee when you register.

Cancellations:

You may be refunded up to \$700.00 for cancellation until May 1, 2017. After that time there are no refunds available.

Hotel:

The Park Central Hotel, 50 Third Street, San Francisco, CA 94103. In the heart of the city that inspired Tony Bennett's timeless song, is the **Park Central San Francisco**, a newly re-imagined hotel that blends an exceptional setting with superlative service. All rooms have floor-to-ceiling windows that frame spectacular views of the city. Located next door to the Contemporary Jewish Museum and amid the vibrancy that defines the South of Market district, this property is a short stroll to everything that makes San Francisco so beloved — the Cable Cars, AT&T Park, shopping at Westfield Ctr, Union Square, the charm of Chinatown, the flavors of Ferry Plaza and the energy of Fisherman's Wharf.

We have obtained a **group rate of \$239/night** (for either Deluxe Single King or Deluxe Double Queens). If you would like to stay extra nights either before or after the tour, the hotel will honor the group rate. Reservations must be made by the registrant by no later than April 1, 2017.
