Effective October 1, 2024, the Jacob Rader Marcus Center of the American Jewish Archives will charge the following for duplicating items from our collections. Prices may vary due to the nature of the archival material being reproduced (e.g. oversized material, extremely fragile material) or if the reproduction is unusually time-consuming or difficult. *The AJA reserves the right to not reproduce a collection if it could cause damage to the original materials.*

Please consult a member of the AJA staff for a specific price quote for your order. The American Jewish Archives accepts payment in check or credit card.

The AJA will not scan or copy more than 10% of a MS collection, not to exceed 500 pages

Digital Camera

Researchers may use digital cameras to capture images with permission of the archival staff. Researchers are asked to fill out a form located at the reference desk and to keep citations of what they photograph. Use of flash equipment is not allowed.
